

Careers plan

The year 10 programme of Careers ensures students are aware of health and safety in the workplace as they build towards planning to attend on a 5-day work experience placement. Students will research health and safety issues and how they can be overcome in the workplace. Students will also reflect on their career's journeys from KS3 and look to discover their skills and qualities and using ICT skills create a CV using the careers platform Xello. Students will attend the autumn careers convention to liaise with employers, apprenticeship providers, local Colleges and Universities. There is also an opportunity for some students in Year 10 to attend a taster day at a local College.
