




HEALTH & SOCIAL CARE

What is it?

The BTEC Nationals in Health and Social Care [HSC] aim to provide learners with a nationally recognised, vocationally specific qualification for entry into employment to one of the HSC sectors or onto university to study on health and social care related degree programmer.

These courses also provide students with a period of mandatory work experience/s in the HSC area. The BTEC Nationals have broad parity with 'A' level qualifications as outlined in the following table.
