



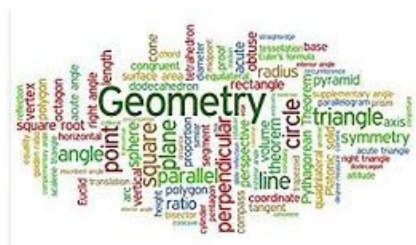

CONTENT

Pure Mathematics - Proof; algebra and functions; coordinate geometry in the (x,y) plane; sequences and series; trigonometry; exponentials and logarithms; differentiation; integration and vectors
Applied Mathematics - Statistical sampling; data presentation and interpretation; probability; statistical distributions; statistical hypothesis testing
Quantities and units in mechanics; kinematics, forces and Newton's laws
